Directions to Six Mile Waterworks, Van Rensselaer Lake

From I 90 West:

Take Exit 2, Fuller Road. At the end of
the ramp, turn right and then make an
immediate left into the park.

From I 90 East:

Take Exit 2, Washington Avenue/UAlbany.
At the end of the ramp turn right and then
make another right onto Fuller Road.
The park is about 1/4 mile down Fuller
Road on your left side.

Tell the parking attendant you are with
the Sunnyview fishing clinic and you will
be able to drive up to the dock to unload
your participants.
