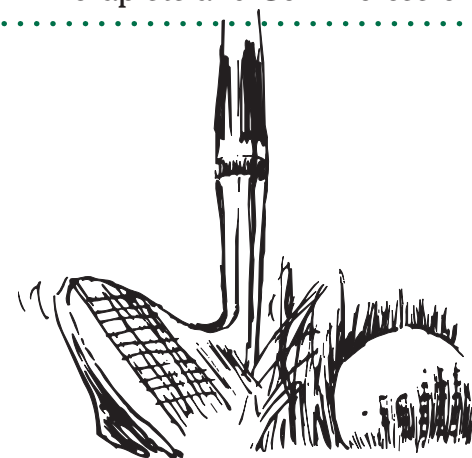

To introduce and review basic golfing techniques and how they can be used therapeutically to improve functional skills, range of motion and balance.

To introduce adaptive equipment and techniques to therapists and golf professionals enabling them to instruct persons with disabilities; encouraging self-confidence and independence with leisure skills.

Program

FIRST SWING SEMINAR..... **8:30 am - 3:30 pm**

For therapists and golf professionals, only.

Morning - This is a classroom instruction covering basic techniques of golf, including rules and special equipment. Participants will learn adaptive techniques and view adaptive equipment that can assist disabled golfers.

Afternoon - Participants will instruct golfers applying the skills gained during the morning session.

LEARN-TO-GOLF CLINIC **12:30 - 3:30 pm**

For golfers with disabilities.

Golf lessons are available for ambulatory and non-ambulatory participants under the direction of the *Learn-to-Golf* instructor, local golf professionals, therapists and staff from Sunnyview Rehabilitation Hospital.
